Timeline

- 29 – 30 April: First JWG workshop – principles drafted, Guide drafting group tasked
- 11 June: Principles and JWG TOR finalised, first draft of Guide completed
- 20 June: Feedback on draft Guide received from wider JWG
- 30 June : Desktop exercise to test Guide with Interim Fruit Fly Council
- 07 July: Desktop exercise to test Guide Animal Sector CE's group
- 09 July: Updated Guide reflecting all feedback sent to JWG for final review
- 14 July: JWG telecon to capture final feedback and confirm as fit-for-purpose
- 22 July: Principles and Guide endorsed by TDGG
- 23 July: Discussion paper circulated to Forum participants
- 22 Aug: Pre-Forum feedback received

Outstanding issues (JWG)

1. Hands-on induction and training for decision-makers
2. Rapid notification -refer Deed clauses 3.2.2a and 6.3.1
3. Criteria for identifying 'directly affected' signatories
4. Developing a rapid Operational Agreement in a response
5. Role of indirectly affected industries in a response
6. Stalemate non-consensus during a response
7. Delegation of Biosecurity Act powers in a response
8. Role of industry in a whole-of-government response

Proposed next steps

1. JWG to consider and address feedback
2. Seek final endorsement of the Guide from the TDGG
3. Publish and release the Guide for use by Signatories
4. Progress outstanding issues as agreed by Forum participants and the TDGG
