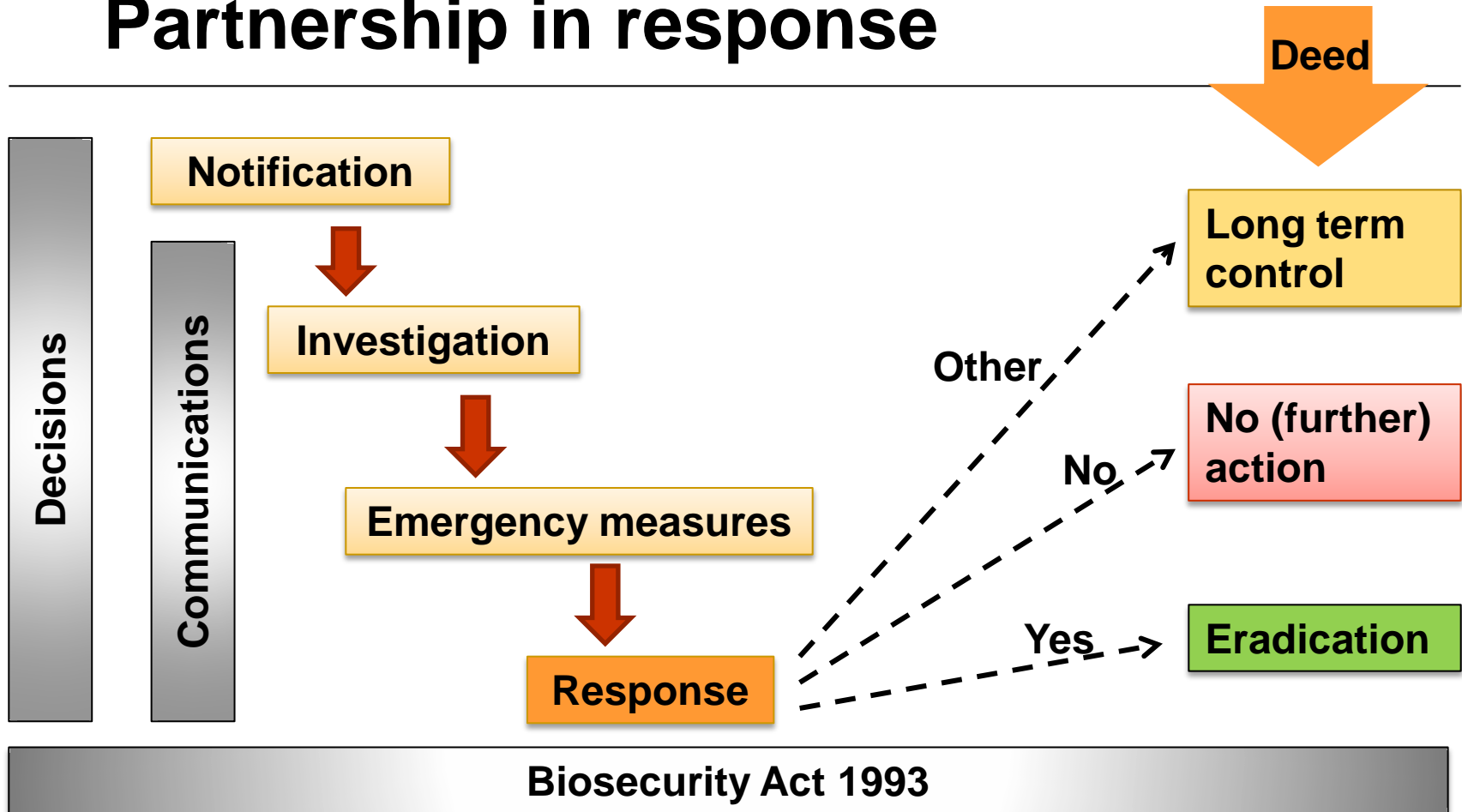
The Biosecurity System



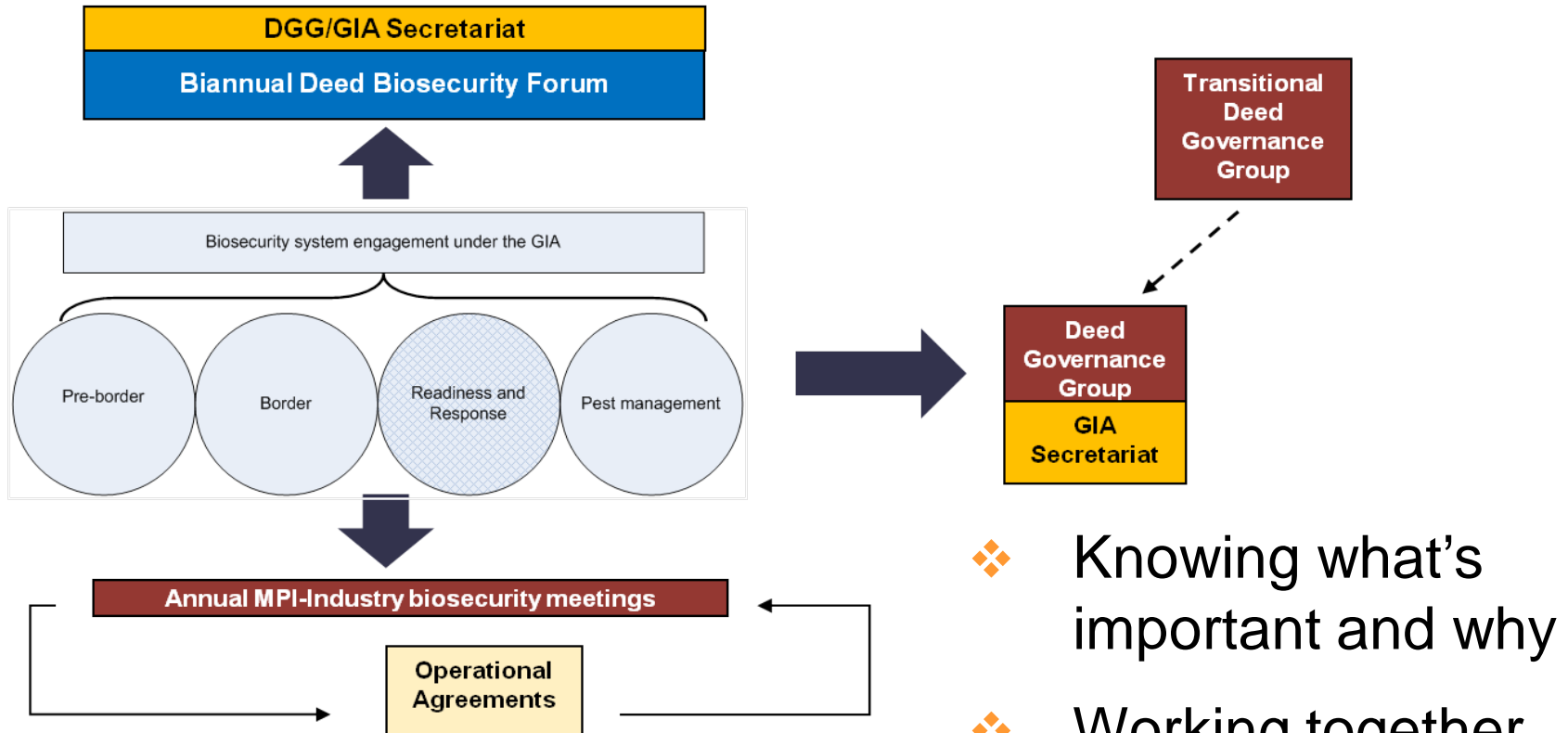
Partnering in readiness

- ❖ Working together to achieve agreed outcomes

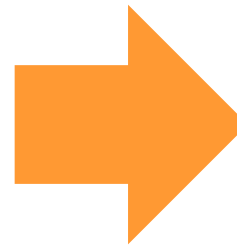
The 5 year plan – don't forget...

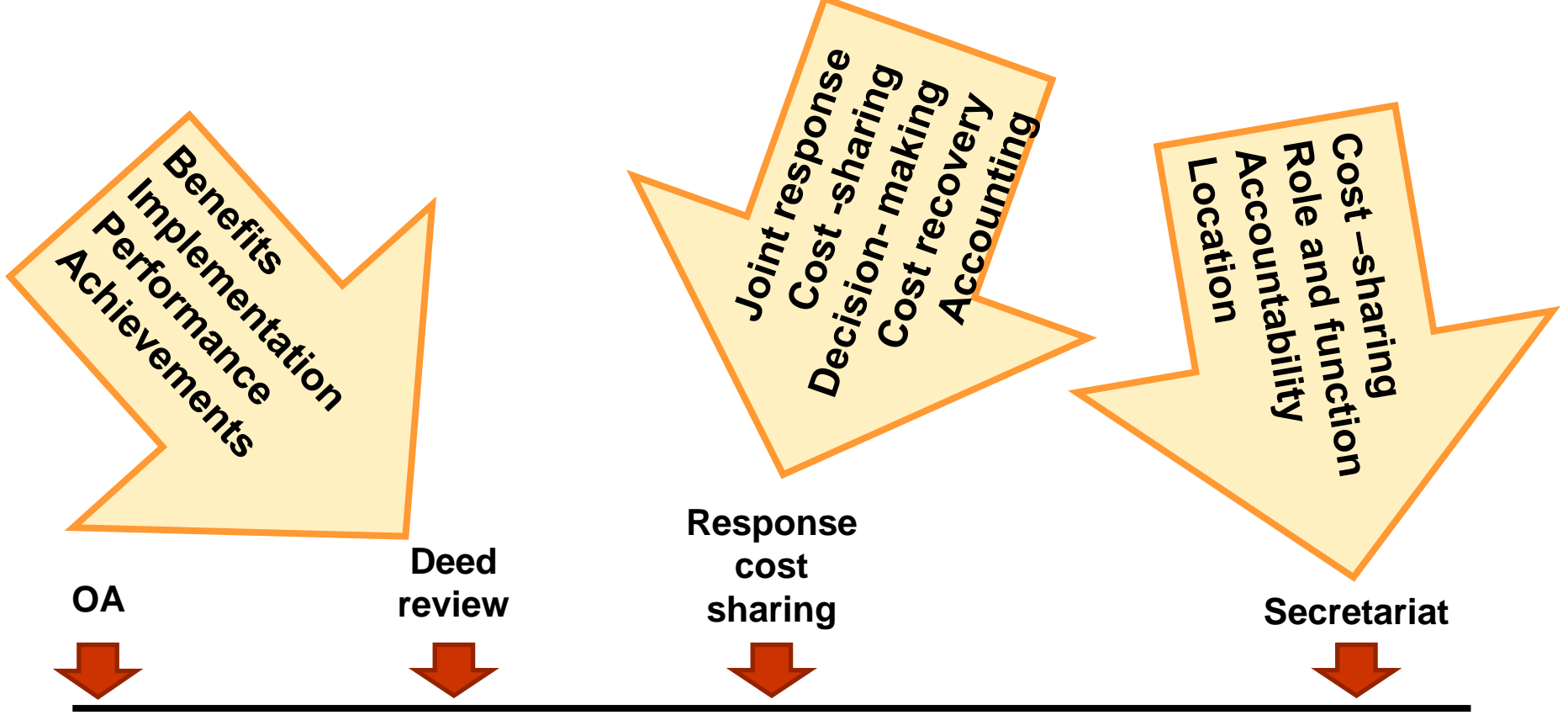
